• Event Registration Forms

You can pick it up at the Administrator's Office. *Even if you have done this activity for years, and have never needed to apply before, it is necessary to do it now.* The principal reasons for it are: 1) we have the opportunity for the Board of Officers to review it for appropriateness, and rule compliance; 2) we assure that the appropriate part of the Lodge is reserved for the Event; 3) we have contact numbers for those running the event; and 4) we have documentation for services needed by the Lodge (such as special foods, bartenders etc).

• E-MAIL ADDRESSES:

Please leave your e-mail address with the Lodge Office. The purpose for this is to enable the Lodge to notify large numbers of members, simultaneously, of information critical to your use and participation in Lodge activities, and decisions. We will still distribute the News Letter by regular mail (unless you request that we don't), but this will enable staff to inform you of changes between regular publications.
