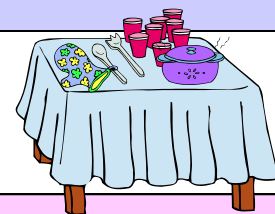

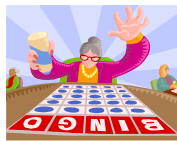

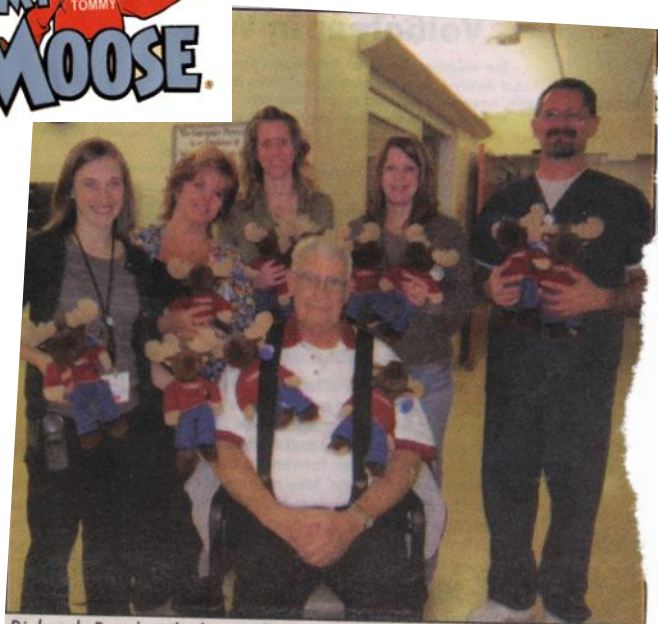
We (the West Bend Moose Lodge) presented a dozen Tommy Moose's to the local Sheriff's Department and Fire & Rescue Department.

The Moose Lodge Funeral
